- 1. New Introductions.** Tom Dietsche
- 2. Minutes passed.**
- 3. Announcements.** Adam Backstrom intends to step down from the Chair position after the July meeting. Candidates are encouraged to step forward.
- 4. Jefferson Avenue Bicycle Lane Response (Liz Boyer).** The City accepted the MGCC resolution to change Jefferson Avenue from Bicycle Boulevard to Enhanced Share Lanes. Liz will contact the City about changing signage for traffic calming.
- 5. Mississippi River Road Bicycle Lane (Mike Sonn).** The joint District Council (Highland, MGCC, Union Park) considering this is in hiatus due to higher priorities with the HDC. The road width and neighbor parking during large home events are issues. Mike Sonn will continue to be involved with the group.
- 6. Mac Grove Moves and Golden Shoes (Liz Boyer)**
 - Moves end June 30th.
 - Both Golden shoes have been returned.
- 7. Housing and Land Use Updates (Liz Boyer)**
 - The South Snelling Zoning Study is before City Council.
 - Our discussion about the pros and cons of the LeCesse request juxtaposed with South Snelling seems moot. After the meeting, a Villager article quoted Chris Tolbert stating the LeCesse Zoning change and the Zoning Study will be considered together!
- 8. Bicycle Rack Resolution (Mike Sonn, Brian Martinson)**
 - Resolution to “Immediately install bicycle parking at new businesses at the corner of Snelling and Stanford and at Randolph and Cleveland” passed.
 - Strategic Resolution to recommend changed language in the Site Plan Review and during Street Reconstruction held over for future discussion.
