1. **New Introductions.** None.
2. **November Minutes** passed.
3. **Lexington Avenue Bikeway** (Reuben Collins).
 - Lexington Avenue Bikeway in Mac Groveland covers the three blocks between Jefferson (N) and James (S). No parking between Jefferson & Juliet. No parking on East side between Juliet and James.
 - Decision to eliminate parking based on fewer spaces lost (12 versus 18) and traffic studies showing lesser utilization (7% versus 14%).
 - Residents on the East Side presented a petition requesting that no parking be moved to the West side. The reasons were difficult access for deliveries and visitors and congestion in cul de sac's on the streets in question. Xx
 - No residents on the West Side were in attendance.
 - Motion to invite residents on both sides of the street to next month's Transportation Meeting to obtain feedback on the options, passed.
4. **2018 Priorities** (Brian Martinson).
 - Grand Avenue Safety – The City has agreed to construct four bump-outs at the Grand – Syndicate Avenue intersection.
 - A-Line Park and Ride to Soccer Games. Engage Metro Transit. Collaborate with HDC and maybe UDC.
 - Randolph Avenue Safety Improvements. Collaborate with HDC.
5. **HLU Update Two Proposals of potential interest** (Liz Boyer)
 - 272 Snelling Development Proposal (adjacent Snelling – St Clair site).
 - 1524 Summit Conditional Use Permit (Church & Performance Arts Center)
