Draft Resolution for consideration:

Whereas most traffic signals in Saint Paul have Pedestrian “WALKING PERSON” or “WALK” signals,

Whereas most of the “Pedestrian Signals” must be triggered by pressing a button,

Whereas at many of these intersection if the Walk Button is not pressed before the light turns green the “WALKING PERSON” or “WALK” signal will not be lit and the stop hand signal will remain lit,

Whereas a DON’T WALK indicator during a green light confuses both the turning driver and the pedestrian,

Be it resolved that the MGCC requests of the City of Saint Paul that at all signalized intersection the “WALKING PERSON” or “WALK” signal be automatically lit whether or not a pedestrian presses the WALK BUTTON.
