- **New Introductions.** None
- **June Minutes passed.**
- **Cretin Avenue (North of Grand) Working Group** (Sean Ryan & Brandon Long)
 - Union Park District Council presented facts about North Cretin.
 - City of St Paul is doing a traffic study, previous data shows heavier volume from 94 to Marshall than Marshall to Grand.
 - Possible reduction of lanes from 4 to 3 south of Marshall.
 - Opportunity to collaborate with other District Councils after study completion.
- **Consistent Walk Signal Resolution** (Dave Pausik).
 - Motion: “City of St Paul ... at all signalized intersections the “WALKING PERSON” or “WALK” be automatically lit whether or not a pedestrian presses the WALK button. (2nd Nathan Zacharias)
 - Adoption believed to increase consistency, reduce confusion, and improve safety.
 - Motion passed without opposition.
- **Snelling & Grand Task Force Resolution Discussion** (Jack Fei)
 - Proposed resolution to create Task Force to recommend safety improvements at the Snelling and Summit Intersection.
 - All stakeholders including District Councils, Cyclists, Historical Preservation, Macalester College, and MDOT. Include Traffic SME.
 - Focus on short term safety fixes and long term recommendations.
 - Jack Fei will draft the resolution and distribute to committee for feedback.
- **Stops for Me Update** (Liz Boyer)

 - Grand and Cambridge temporarily impacted by added signage
