- The top three designs will be selected by the Community Building Committee. The MGCC Board of Directors will choose the winning design.
- MGCC reserves the right to use all designs for future marketing purposes.
- No reproduced images will be accepted. Your submission must be original artwork.
- There is no limit to the number of entries per entrant during the entry period.
- If your submission needs to be reproduced to ensure the highest quality of printing, we will do our best to recreate the most accurate design.

Selection of winner: January 2019

Winner will be notified via email.
