- **New Introductions.** None
- **July Minutes passed.**
- **Consistent Walk Signal Resolution** (Jack Fei)
 - The resolution was returned for rework by the Executive Committee.
 - The Walk Signal goals (increase consistency, reduce confusion, and improve safety) received support but the solution were too specific and scope too broad.
 - After discussion, the consensus was to invite a Traffic Engineer to attend a committee meeting to explain: Walk Signal options and a scope for a revised Walk Signal resolution.
- **Snelling & Grand Task Force Resolution** (Jack Fei)
 - The resolution for a Safety Task Force proposes organizing stakeholders and creating an open collaborative decision process.
 - There is an informal "Sustain Ward 3" group whose scope of work and efforts overlap areas covered by the resolution.
 - The consensus was to have the "Sustain Ward 3" group explain their work to improve safety to at the Snelling & Summit Intersection. .
- **Mac Grove Moves Android App** (Alex Cuniffe)
 - Alex Cuniffe gave a demo of a prototype Android "Mac Grove Moves" application.
 - Committee members strongly encouraged the application be made production ready.
- **Grand Avenue Pedestrian Safety** (Liz Boyer)
 - Grand & Syndicate: four bump-outs are being built
 - Grand & Cambridge: bollards are installed and more data samples will be collected
- **HLU Update** (Jack Fei)
