Transportation recommendations

1. March 2019: "Whereas: St. Paul has committed to increasing the bicycle mode share to 2% by 2020 and 5% by 2025 and the bicycling commuter share from 0.6% to 2.5% by 2025.

Whereas: Most of the city's bike lanes are unusable and unsafe during the winter as a result of motor-vehicle and snow blocking the lanes.

Be it resolved: That the City of St. Paul must ensure the safety and navigability of bike lanes year round. Accordingly, the City should consider additional snow removal and parking bans to make our bike lanes clear of obstruction."
