What is the Consolidated Plan? The City of Saint Paul receives approximately \$8-9 million in federal funds each year from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for housing and community development projects and programs. In order to receive this HUD funding, the City must prepare a five-year Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan addresses the City's housing and community development needs, and identifies five-year priorities for how to use these funds, including Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG).
