Introductions /Additions or Deletions to Agenda

- Brian would like to discuss a future change in the CBC Committee Chair and other roles.

Approval of January 2020 Minutes

- Craig noted there was an incomplete sentence “Britta will create...” in the minutes. Joyce will resubmit with the minor correction “Britta will create **a list of potential neighborhood locations for offsite meetings**”.
- With this change, the January 2020 minutes were unanimously approved by voice vote. Craig moved the motion and Tom seconded.

2020 Committee Work Plan

- Britta distributed a template for the CBC 2020 Work Plan
- Goals discussed:
 - Host at least 3 meetings offsite to increase the visibility of MGCC and CBC
 - Focus on these events being more inclusive:
 - Plant Share – houseplants, container gardening
 - Alley Garden Awards – emphasis on more than just gardens, also look to include businesses
 - Garage Sale – involve renters
 - Student Off Campus Rental Gathering – partner with one or more universities to host an event to share information/resources with new student off-campus renters.
- Other ideas for the future:
 - House Party – host an event at your home and invite neighbors to get to know more about MGCC and also each other
 - Block Leaders/Captains – how can we tap into this group of engaged neighbors
 - Quarterly Pop-Up Events – such as the Read Brave event

Pop-Up Planning: April 22nd Read Brave book discussion

- Meggie has taken the lead on this event which we expect to host as UST
- Agreed to host just one event and invite other colleges/universities

Mac Grove Fest 2020 Task Force

- A Mac Grove Task Force has been created
- Britta distributed a handout listing 6 key roles for which we need volunteers
- This Task Force will meet from 6 to 6:30 PM prior to our CBC meetings. Please consider volunteering for one of the roles. Other MGCC board and committee members will also be encouraged to participate.
