1. **Introductions:** none.
2. **February 2020 minutes.** Dave Pausik, Hugo Bruggeman (2nd), passed.
3. **Summit Avenue Restriping** (Reuben Collins)
 - The 12-2019 Proposal restriping contract is awarded: cost \$360,000.
 - Scope: Summit Ave from Mississippi River Blvd to Lexington Avenue
 - Work begins in early May, no interaction with Ayd Mill Road project.
 - Work occurs after pothole patching, possible mill and overlay work 2022 - 2024.
4. **Road Closures and Shelter In Place** (Brian Martinson)
 - St Paul Parks and Recreation has temporary partial lane closures on Mississippi River Blvd, Comp Park, Phalen Park, Cherokee Park, and Mounds Blvd.
 - Committee members can contact Public Works for lane closures on Jefferson Avenue from Mississippi River Blvd to Hamline Ave to accommodate more cyclists and fewer drivers.
5. **Pedestrian Crosswalk Signal Buttons** (Cindy Radke)
 - The Committee decided to forward the January Resolution with a letter mentioning “maintenance cost avoidance” and covid 19 anxiety as new reasons for adoption.
 - Public Works will be invited to attend a meeting to discuss signal buttons.
6. **Ayd Mill Road Update** (Gene Johnson)
 - The three lane Ayd Mill Road mill and overlay project is now approved by the City.
 - A future follow-up item is impacts created by access to Allianz Field events.
7. **CIB Community Project Update** (Jack Fei)
 - The St Paul CIB Committee met April 13 meeting, next meeting is May 11.
 - The Community Ideas are “Under Review” and “Formal Applications” will be requested.
 - The review process will include District Councils.
 - The selection deadline is driven by City Budget approvals, extension to July at the latest.
