Approval of October 2020 Minutes

Frost Fest 2021 Discussion and Planning

- We could display decorated pucks in a vacant storefront or collaborate with Wet Paint to hang them up in their windows, post photos on the MGCC website, etc.
- People could create snow sculptures in their yards, take photos, and submit them online, and we could also attach MGCC sponsor signs to the sculptures.
- Participants could use a MGCC Frost Fest hashtag when posting puck photos on social media.
- Looking at a span of time a week to ten days for the fest. CBC members could judge the sculptures and MGCC could offer giftcards from Mac-Grove businesses.
- Brian will reach out to Wet Paint to inquire about partnering.
- Considering scheduling modified Frost Fest for the last week of January into the first week of February.

Mac-Grove Webinar Series Promotion & Planning

- <u>Two new webinars</u> currently scheduled: November 18 overdose prevention training and December 8 coping with mental health during COVID-19 training.
- Idea of mapping prejudice webinar(s) will be brought to the next HLU meeting. We could ask the presenter to create a short presentation format version.
- Considering a Mac-Groveland focused webinar on climate change in our neighborhood and what we can expect in the coming years, possibly with a meteorologist and in January or February. Ideas: Russ Stark, Paul Douglas, Paul Huttner. Cathy Plessner will reach out to Russ Stark.
- Bell Museum has been creating virtual programs on topics aligned with climate change.
- Brian reached out to Chris Tolbert about additional webinar ideas: property taxes (having County Assessor share how property taxes are calculated), modification and development of snowplow plan (could collaborate with the Transportation Committee for this), and engaging seniors during COVID.

CBC Structure Discussion

- Possible structure change might look like reducing regular meeting schedule of the full committee to quarterly meetings, but with committed project planning occurring between meetings.
- Suggestions: Ability to call meetings as needed; must be transparency throughout.
- Some groups might want to check in more often with MGCC staff while others might appreciate more independence.
- We could use a Google Group to communicate in between meetings.
- By majority approval, starting in January, the committee will begin meeting quarterly.
